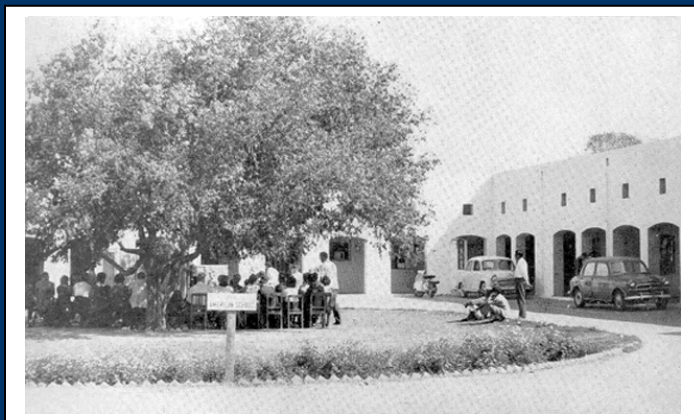

There are a limited number of guests for each of the events outside of the hotel due to the host's restrictions (for instance, the Gandhi Memorial Center and Indian Embassy) or number of tour guides available. We encourage guests who know which events they would like to attend to pre-reserve now to make sure they can get a spot. There will be information on events that still have openings (and spots opening due to cancellations) at the AIS/AES Reunion Registration Desk and you may also sign up then, as long as there are vacancies.

Traveling D.C. by Metro

Many of the reunion events which take place outside of the hotel are easily reached by the Metro (subway) system. To get to the Crystal City Metro stop, just take a short 5-minute walk down the tunnel located to the left of the hotel registration desk and follow the signs. The Early Bird pricing was over on May 23, however you can still register online and we are accepting registrations up until the reunion begins.

Reunion Package Fee: \$280/person and \$65 children under age 12 PLUS Handling Fee: \$50/Alumni Only* Late Fee: \$50

EXAMPLE: Alumni (or Faculty) Only:
 \$280 package
 \$ 50 handling fee
 \$ 50 late fee
 \$380 total

EXAMPLE: Alumni (or Faculty) + 1 guest:
 \$280x2 = \$560 package
 \$ 50 handling fee
 \$ 50 late fee
 \$660 total

*** Notes on Registration Fee:**

- Handling Fee includes \$25 annual alumni association fee + administrative costs
- Handling Fee is only for the alumni so his/her guests are not charged additional registration fee
- AIS/AES Alumni who are married to each other or an alumni parent/alumni student relationship pay one Handling Fee of \$50 only

Hotel costs are additional for those who stay at the hotel.

Before you start, have your Pay Pal account (preferable) or credit card (Master Card or VISA) information ready. If you choose to use Pay Pal and do not have an account yet, please sign up at <https://www.paypal.com> several days in advance, so Pay Pal can approve your account.

Web Browser

RegOnline does not always work with AOL. For our AOL users: To ensure your registration is completed and accepted, we suggest you use Internet Explorer, Firefox, or Google Chrome to access RegOnline.

Registration Steps

1. Please register yourself (alumni or faculty member) first. The cost for the alumni or faculty member includes both the registration fee (to cover class dues and administrative costs) and your event fee. Do not exit the program if you are adding addition guests on your bill.
2. After you have registered yourself, you will have the opportunity to add guests and children using the **Add Another Person** button. You will register each guest/family member one at a time.
3. Continue going back to the **Add Another Person** for each person you register. By registering in this fashion, you can register yourself and your entire group on one bill.
 - *Tip: The program will ask you for an email address and password for each person you register. You may continue using your own email address and password for all people you are registering.*
4. Before checking out, be sure you included all guests.
5. You will receive an email confirmation for each person you register. Also, you may set the system to provide you with reminder emails (as if you could forget!) before the reunion.
6. If you want to add more guests to your registration, you may go back later to add them to your account.

Signing Up for Events Outside Hotel

1. Go to https://www.regonline.com/aisaes_reunion_2010.
2. Use your email and password you used to register for the reunion. If you can't remember your password, email sophie.lafaille@gmail.com.
3. Go to the **Agenda** page in the registration
4. Select the events you want to attend. You cannot sign up for overlapping events. You will be able to add the other guests you registered also if you registered as a group (e.g., you and your spouse). You will not be able to register other people that were not included in your original registration.
5. All events have a maximum number of attendees. If the event is full, you will be notified that you will not be able to sign up.
6. Please only sign up for events that you know you will be able to attend, as we have a limited number of spots for each event and there may be others who want to go also!
7. If for any reason you are unable to attend an event that you have signed up for, we would appreciate if you could notify Sophie Lafaille (sophie.lafaille@gmail.com) as soon as possible.

Making Hotel Reservations

Need to make hotel reservations for the Reunion Weekend?

Our venue for the 2010 is the Crystal Gateway Marriott Hotel in Crystal City, VA, which is located across the river from Washington D.C.

The deadline for making reservations for a hotel room at the hotel and getting the special price was June 4, however as we post this newsletter they still had about 30 rooms left in our reserved block, although the price will now be their standard going price on the day you make reservations.

The hotel offers free shuttle service to the Reagan National Airport, which is conveniently located nearby. Parking is also available at an additional cost. The Crystal City Metro stop is easily accessible (a short walk through the lobby) for those of you planning to attend the July 4 festivities in D.C.
